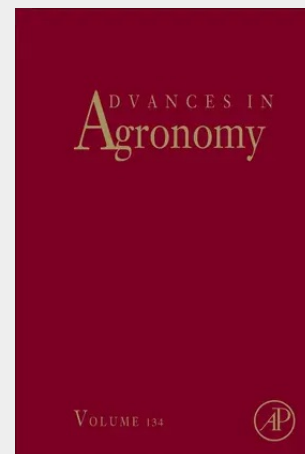


Advances in Agronomy
