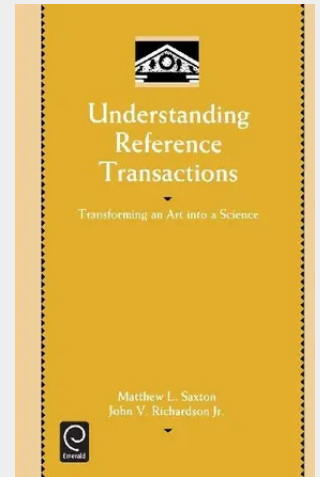


Understanding Reference Transactions
