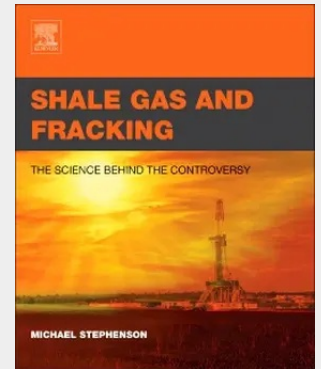


Shale Gas and Fracking
