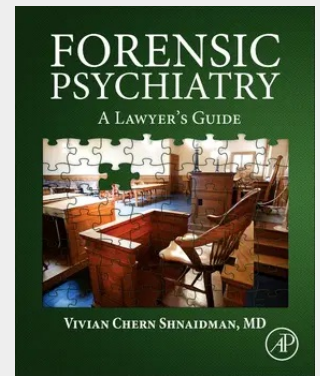


Forensic Psychiatry
