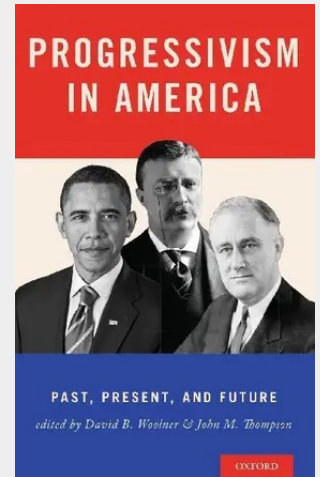


Progressivism in America
