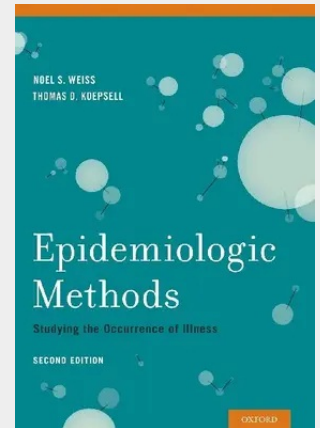


Epidemiologic Methods
