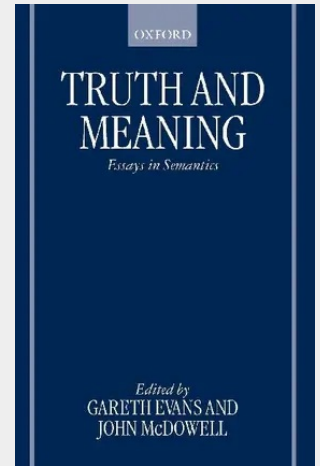


Truth and Meaning
