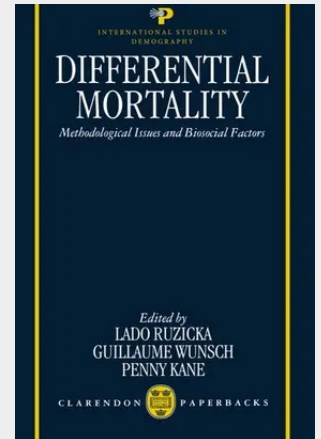


Differential Mortality
