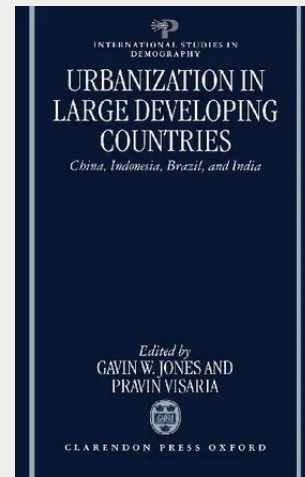


Urbanization in Large Developing Countries
