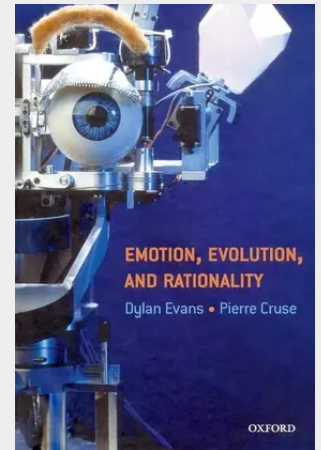


Emotion, Evolution and Rationality
