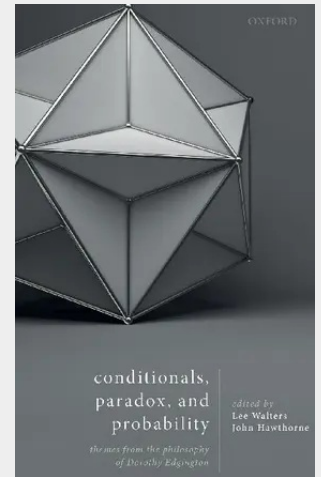


CONDITIONALS PARADOX PROBABILITY C
