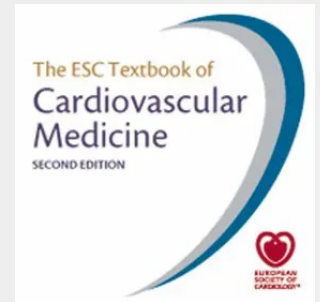


Quantitative Techniques in Geography
