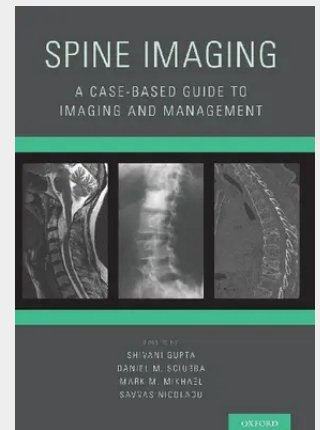


Spine Imaging
