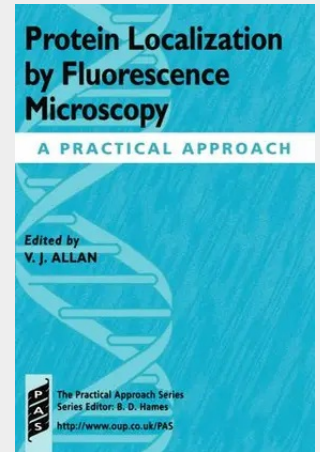


Protein Localization by Fluorescence Microscopy: A Practical Approach
