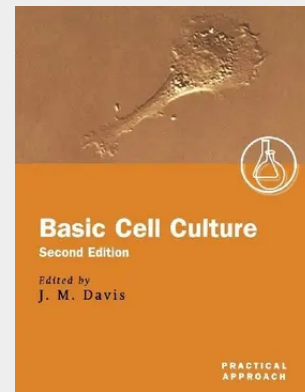


Basic Cell Culture
