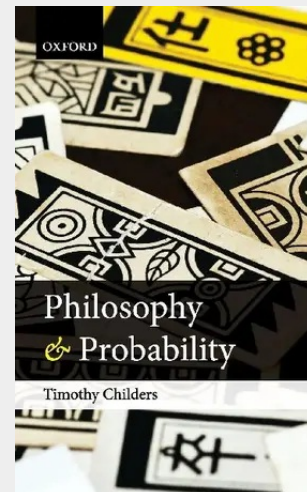


PHILOSOPHY & PROBABILITY C
