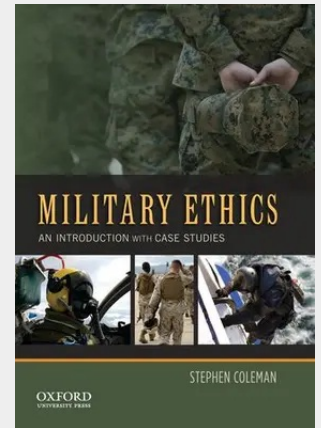


Military Ethics
