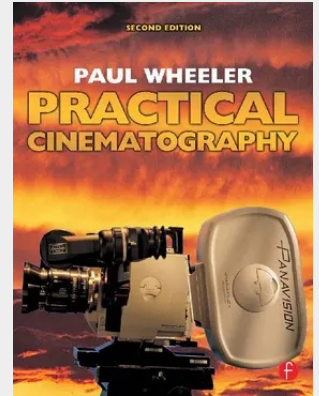


Practical Cinematography
