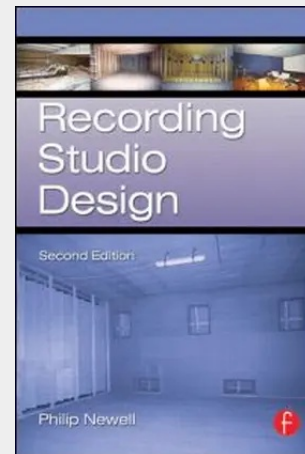


Recording Studio Design
