

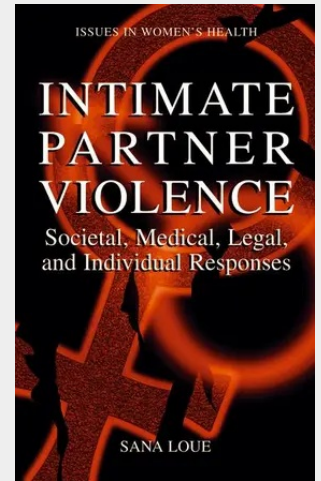
Intimate Partner Violence
