

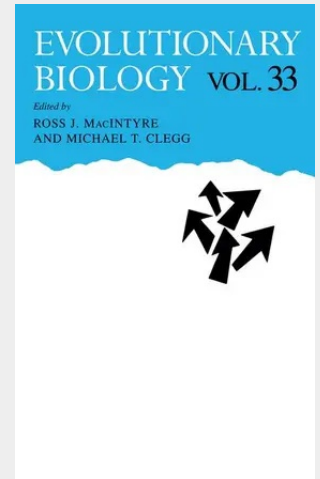
Evolutionary Biology
