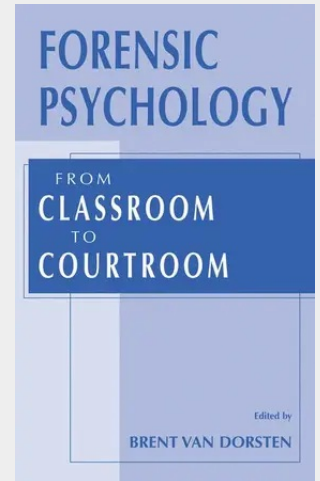
Forensic Psychology
