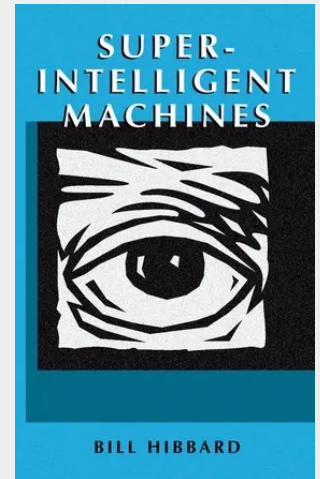


Super-Intelligent Machines
