

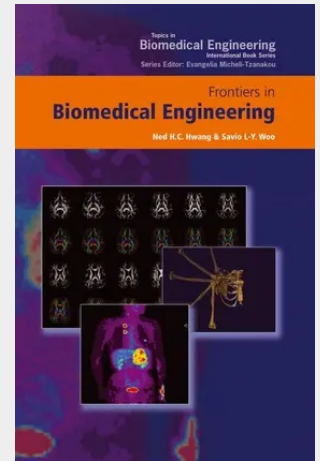
Frontiers in Biomedical Engineering
