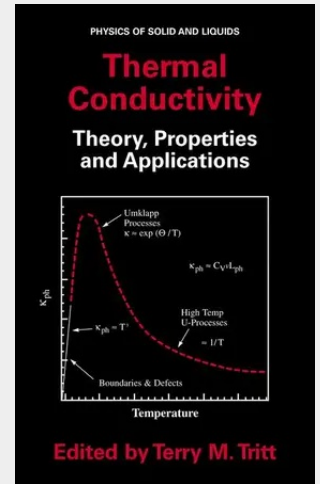


Thermal Conductivity
