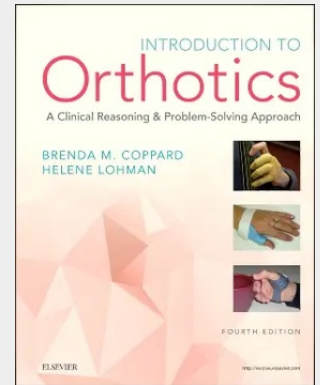


Introduction to Orthotics: A Clinical Reasoning and Problem-Solving Approach
