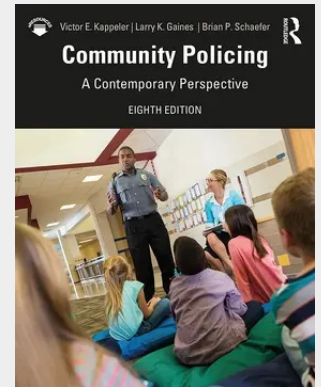


Community Policing
