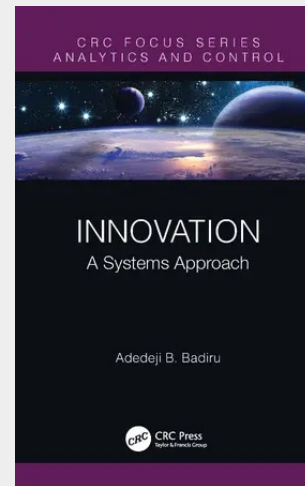


Innovation: A Systems Approach
