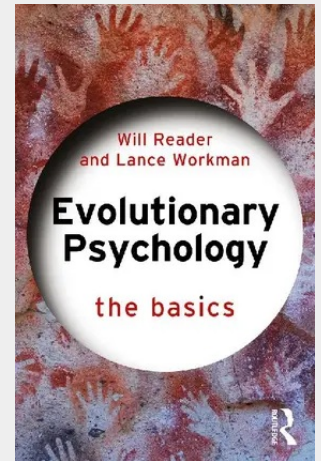


Evolutionary Psychology
