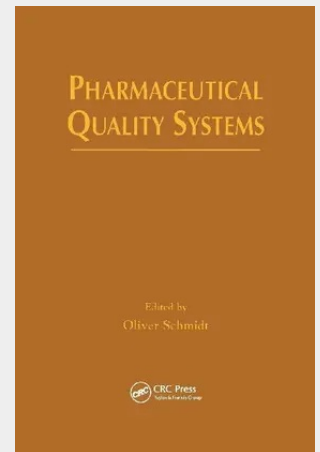


Pharmaceutical Quality Systems
