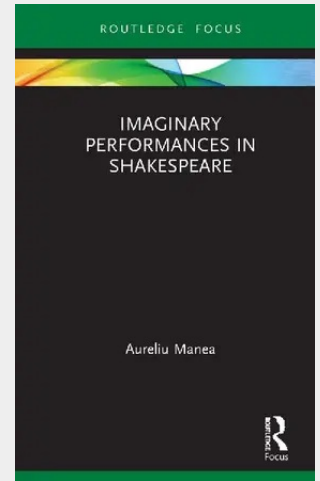


Imaginary Performances in Shakespeare
