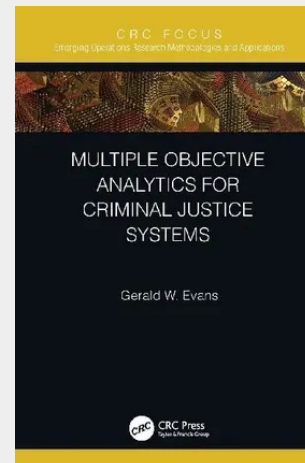


Multiple Objective Analytics for Criminal Justice Systems
