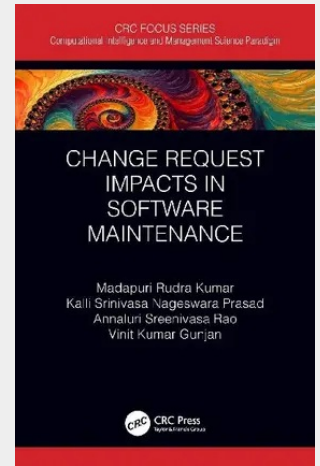


Change Request Impacts in Software Maintenance
