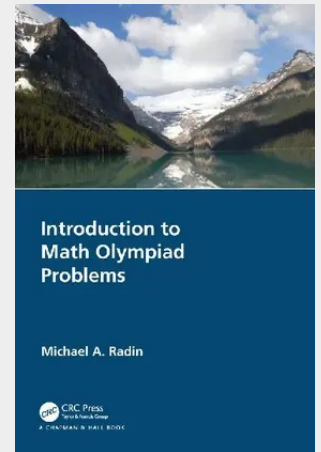


Introduction to Math Olympiad Problems
