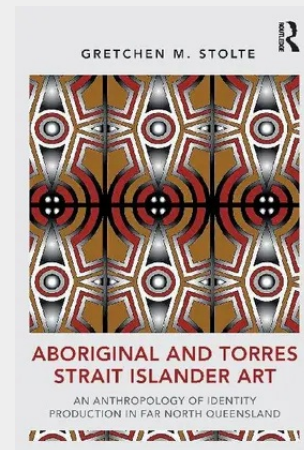


Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Art
