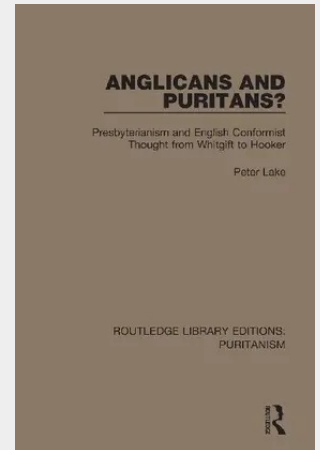


Anglicans and Puritans?
