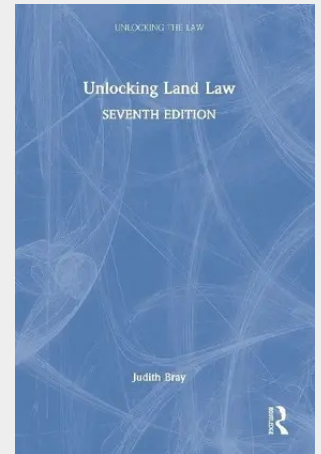


Unlocking Land Law
