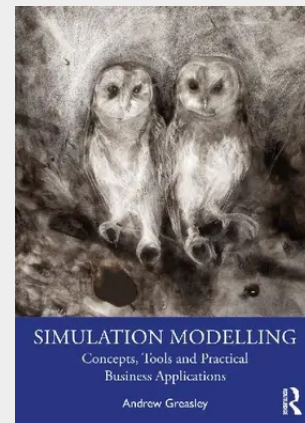


Simulation Modelling

While simulation has a vast area of application, this textbook focuses on the use of simulation to analyse business processes.
