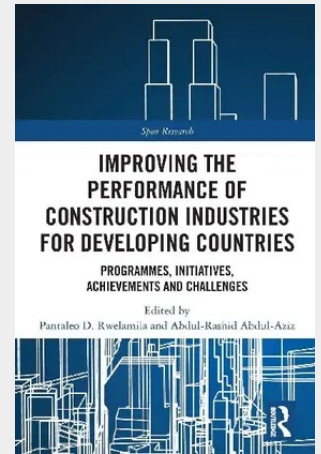


Improving the Performance of Construction Industries for Developing Countries
