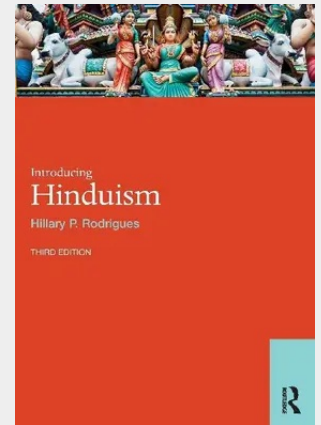


Introducing Hinduism
