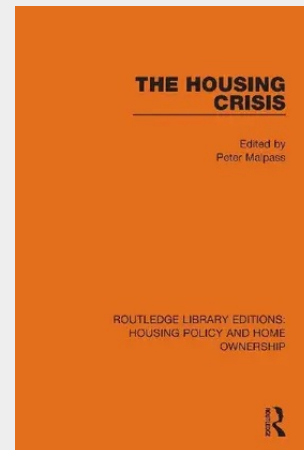


The Housing Crisis
