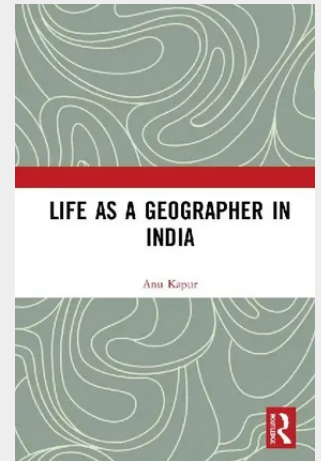


Life as a Geographer in India
