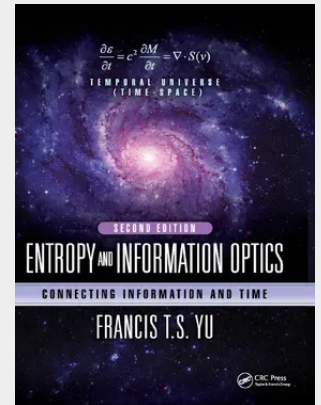


Entropy and Information Optics
