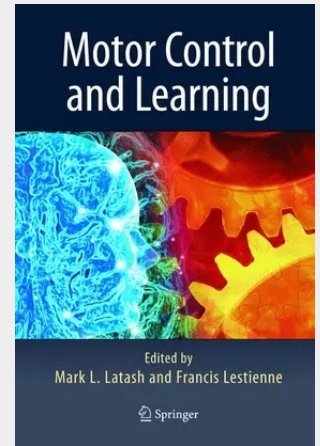


Motor Control and Learning

This book emphasizes the links between progress in basic motor control research and applied areas such as motor disorders and motor rehabilitation.
