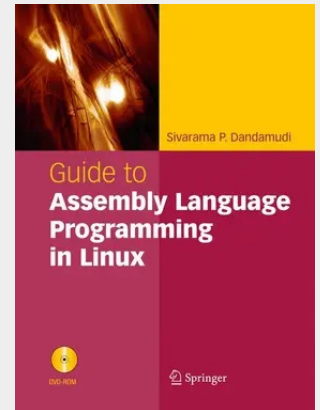


Guide to Assembly Language Programming in Linux
