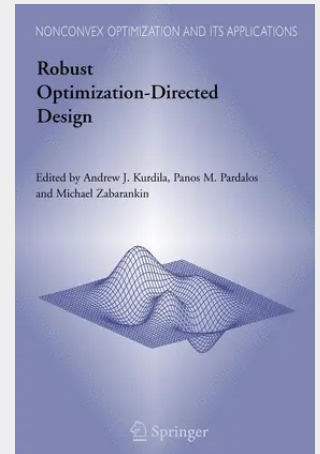


Robust Optimization-Directed Design
