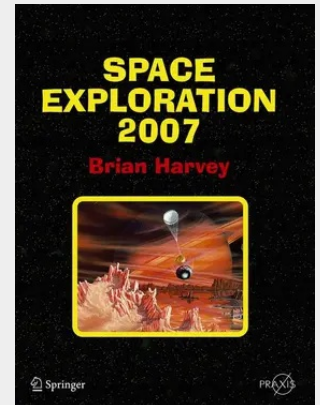
Space Exploration 2007
