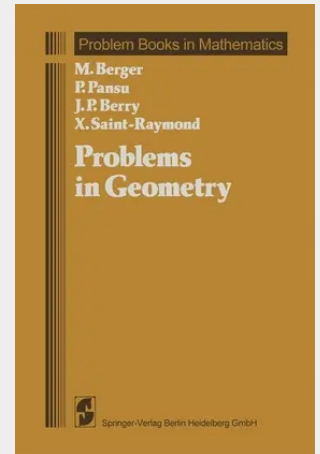


Problems in Geometry
