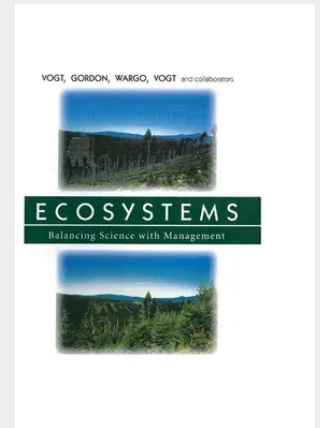


Ecosystems
