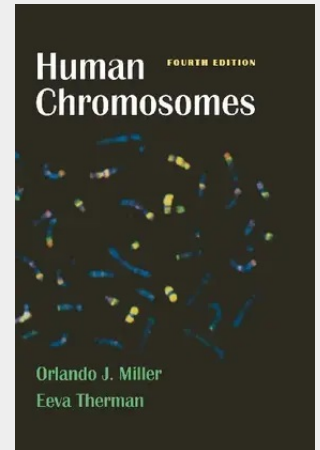


Human Chromosomes
